CARNEGIE STREET PARK AND MUGA

The Council have asked us to make some amendments to the approved drawings including redesigning the access into the MUGA, boundary treatments, and some other design details.

We have submitted an updated design proposal to them, to respond to their feedback.

Unfortunately, the changes mean we have needed to pause the construction works on the park for the moment and we will need to wait until the updated design proposal has been approved by the Council before we can recommence work. We are working to secure their approval as soon as possible.

The pause will inevitably result in a delay in the completion of works and opening of the new facilities. We now estimate an opening in December but will keep you regularly updated.

We estimate the existing basketball court will need to be closed after the summer holidays in early September, to enable construction on this area to begin.



CONSTRUCTION **UPDATE - DEMOLITION** AND HOARDING

We have started surveys in Blackmore House in preparation for demolition works.

Hoarding has been erected outside parts of Blackmore House. The hoarding has been installed on the Copenhagen Street side of the building, the works will also have a small return down Bryan Street.

The red lines on the aerial opposite represent where the first part of the hoarding will be.

Once the last few residents vacate Blackmore House, hoarding will be going up behind Blackmore House and Mayor House too.



We currently have residents in occupation in Blackmore House so we are unable to give a firm date for demolition at the moment. We are working together to relocate residents and once this has been achieved, we can begin building the new homes.

OPEN SPACE CONSULTATION

We would like to thank the residents who were able to attend the consultation sessions on Monday 26th June where we discussed options for the management of the new outside spaces including parks, courtyards and the MUGA. A draft plan will be shared with residents shortly for further input.

INITIAL DEMOLITION NOTICE

Residents in New Barnsbury will have received an Initial Demolition Notice advising you that the buildings will be demolished on or before June 2030.

We don't have dates at the moment but when confirmed you will receive a Final Demolition Notice.

The purpose of the Notice is to suspend completion of Right to Buy sales while the transformation is in progress. Your Right to Buy will be reinstated on expiry of the Notice or when you move to your new home.
