## RBG, KEW BEGIN THEIR BIODIVERSITY MISSION

We've kicked off on our commitment to improve the biodiversity quality of the estate with the first phase of research being carried out by Royal Botanical Gardens, Kew scientist **Dr Janine Griffiths-Lee**. She visited the The Barnsbury Estate to sample the existing biodiversity, discovering and recording what wildlife and plants currently exist currently here.

This research is important to measure the improvement to biodiversity we'll bring with an injection of new plants and consideration for pollinators and wildlife as the transformation progresses.



## DEMOLITION OF BLACKMORE HOUSE

You should have received a letter from us explaining that the government has announced new building safety standards will be introduced for residential buildings soon. Further information from the government on these standards is expected in the autumn, and these may have an impact on the design and construction of your homes.

We have therefore made the difficult decision to pause on the demolition and construction of homes until the government releases further details. Your safety is of paramount importance to us.



### CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

We need to pause on the delivery of Phase 1a while we await further information from the government about new building safety standards.

Unfortunately, the works to Carnegie Park remain on hold while we await approval from Islington Council for the updated plans.

We held an update presentation meeting on **Tuesday 8**<sup>th</sup> **August** with an update on how plans are progressing for refurbished homes on Old Barnsbury, including the heating and ventilation systems proposed, why certain options have been discounted, and the designs of kitchens and bathrooms.

## How Newlon will be allocating existing homes on New and Old Barnsbury Estate

Our plan is to allocate any Barnsbury Estate voids in the following order of priority:

- 1 Addressing any housing need arising from a mismatch of housing need against what is being built in phase 1a. For example:
  - Any households requiring larger properties, i.e. 5+ bedroom properties, could be offered rehousing for their adult children in one-bedroom units, where it would reduce the size of property required.
  - Where an overcrowded family in a smaller property can have their housing need addressed by allocating them a void elsewhere on the estate.
- **2** Leaseholders in Messiter, Molton and Jocelin who are taking up the offer of shared equity.
  - There are no leasehold properties in the first homes being built so we will need to provide accommodation elsewhere on the estate.
- **3** Medical transfer for Barnsbury residents who have been accepted onto the Newlon transfer list using **nowmedical** to assess their needs.
- **4** Overcrowded households across the estate.
  - If an overcrowded household is offered a property in Old Barnsbury that meets their housing need, they will not be made an offer of a property in the new build development unless there is a change in their circumstances.
- **5** Under-occupied households across the estate.

#### Please note the following:

Any voids in Messiter, Molton and Jocelin, unless a one-bedroom property, will only be used as temporary decants to minimise the risk of a mismatch of households and an increase in demand for the first homes to be built in phase 1a.

The London Borough of Islington have agreed to consider rehousing people from the estate if they are assessed as being in housing need i.e. for medical reasons or if they are overcrowded and are on their housing needs register, but they will not be regarded as 'decants' and will not receive priority for this.



#### RSG PALETTE SHORTLISTING FEEDBACK



RSG members helped to shortlist the final palettes for the kitchen and bathrooms of the new development.

The group looked at a variety of 5 palettes images with different colours and styles. The group individually fed back on what they thought would work well. The group unanimously decided on three palettes out of a shortlist of 5.

The chosen palettes with samples will be shown to the residents moving in the future.
