





TEST OF OPINION RESULT: MAJORITY OF HOUSEHOLDS IN FAVOUR OF PROPOSALS!

Thank you to everyone who engaged with us over the past few weeks during the Test of Opinion period.

We are pleased to share that 221 households (67% turnout) participated in the Test of Opinion, with 78% of participants in favour of our revised proposals for Barnsbury.







During this period, we knocked on doors and delivered the Test of Opinion bulletin, which contained all the information you needed. We had some great conversations with residents about the plans for Barnsbury, and we value all the feedback you gave us.

As well as door-knocking, Newlon and Mount Anvil were available at the community centre, offering free hot drinks and sweet treats for you to enjoy while asking any questions you had. It was wonderful to see so many of you drop in and say hello, and we hope you enjoyed your drink!

We also held two consultations, on the 6th and 8th of February, where we shared the latest updates to the New Barnsbury proposals, and attendees could discuss them with the project team ahead of us submitting a planning application to Islington Council. These consultations were attended by 37 people, and as always, we welcomed all feedback and questions about the development. It's not too late feedback; you can still share your views using the Better Barnsbury website.

Following the Test of Opinion and consultations, the next steps are to submit a new planning application to Islington Council with our final design. We will share an updated timeline as soon as we have firm dates.
